1. EVENT TITLE DATE & VENUE

2. ORGANISATION & STATUS

Held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd (CAMS), the Race Meeting Standing Regulations (RMSR), and the Sporting Car Club – 2019 CAMS SA State Championship Series Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations or Bulletins that may be issued.

5. ENTRIES

ENTRIES ARE REQUIRED USING www.meecamsau.com

The Entry Fee shall be as detailed. Entry Forms must be completed in full, accompanied by the Entry Fee and lodged with the Secretary of the Meeting. Refusal of entries shall be in accordance with NCR 83 and the relevant Category Sporting Regulations. The maximum number of entries will be 250.

Such fees shall not be refundable except -

(a) In the case of abandonment, cancellation or postponement of the Meeting, in accordance with NCR 59.

(b) In the case of Competitor's cars withdrawn by written advice to the Secretary of the Meeting no later than five

days before the meeting.

- (c) Competitors from New Zealand may be eligible to enter under the Trans-Tasman Agreement. Entries from International competitors will be accepted, subject to being granted a visa from CAMS or their home ASN.

A fee of \$25 will be charged to cover administrative costs associated with a refund. Any cheque dishonored will incur the bank fee as well as a \$25 administration fee. Entries accepted in order of receipt.

6. EVENTS

- (a) Each competing automobile shall be such as complies with the specifications of 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 5th or 6th Category automobiles as outlined in the current CAMS Race Meeting Standing Regulations and CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, and for the categories as detailed in the current CAMS Sporting Car Club of SA Inc. 2019 State Motor Racing Championship Series Regulations.
- (b) Fuel shall be in accordance with Schedule G of the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.
- (c) Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with the noise restrictions in the Race Meeting Standing Regulations.
- (d) The Clerk of the Course shall be the Judge of Fact for noise restrictions and facts to be judged in the Race Meeting Standing Regulations.

7. RACES

- (a) It is envisaged that there will be at least 4 races for each category with the length of the races to be determined at the close of entries. Refer Further Regulations and Final Schedule.
- (b) The Organisers reserve the right to combine or delete categories.

8. AWARDS

Refer CAMS Sporting Car Club of SA Inc. 2019 State Motor Racing Championship Series Regulations for details.

9. LICENCE REQUIREMENTS

Competitors must hold the minimum of a current CAMS level PCC licence.

10. AUTOMATIC TIMING

The Organisers utilise an automatic timing system, which requires all race vehicles to be fitted with an operating Dorian DATA-1 timing transmitter anytime the race vehicle is on the track, which is the Competitor's responsibility. Data 1 transmitters are available from Dorian Industries, 6/29 Graham Court, Hoppers Crossing, VIC, 3129.

The correct transmitter number must be recorded on the Entry Form.

11. GARAGES & PRIVATE PRACTICE

All Garages or Carports are to be reserved and paid for as part of the entry process. (www.meecamsau.com) All enquiries regarding Private Practice on Friday 28th June 2019 should be directed to The Bend Motorsport Park, Telephone 8200-5247 between 9.00am and 5.00pm, Monday to Friday.

12. PROTESTS

Competitors are reminded of their protest rights; refer NCR Part XII of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

13. TIMES

For Documentation Times and Details, Drivers Briefing Times & Details, and Race Schedule refer to Further Regulations.

14. DOCUMENTATION

Competitors are to present valid CAMS Licence and the Driver's current CAMS competition licence(s), CAMS-affiliated car club membership card and CAMS vehicle log book at Documentation for verification.

15. MEDICAL

Will be operating as per CAMS MEDICAL SERVICES/REQUIREMENTS-Medical Services at Motor Sport Events-

3.1.4.3 Alternative for Club, Multi-Club or State Championship Race Meetings.

16. ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

17. PARADES/MEETING RIDES/DEMONSTRATIONS

Any Parade or Demonstration will be conducted in accordance with NCR 20A and 20B respectively.

This Event will include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the CAMS MSPRA Policy.
