Subject: Media Accreditation - SCCSA Motorsport Events

The Sporting Car Club of South Australia (SCCSA) requires the attached media accreditation document to be submitted by members of the media and public relations industry whenever they request media accredited status at any event organised by SCCSA.

This form is available to be downloaded from the SCCSA website (<http://www.sportingcarclub.com.au>), and is accessed under the 'Forms' tab. The accuracy and completeness of this form is the sole responsibility of the applicant. If you have any questions about completing the form please contact the SCCSA Events Office.

Please also note that as SCCSA conducts all its motorsport events under Motorsport Australia permits, applicants are expected to hold valid Motorsport Australia media accreditation when working at a SCCSA motorsport event. Motorsport Australia media accreditation ensures Public Liability Insurance and Personal Accident Insurance are provided in line with the coverage's that a Motorsport Australia event permit includes.

If current Motorsport Australia media accreditation is not held, applicants MUST, as a minimum, provide evidence that the organisation they represent will be covering the applicant under that organisation's public liability and worker's compensation insurances at all times the applicant is at the event. This information must be attached with the application submission. Even if media accreditation to an SCCSA event is granted in this circumstance, the access areas available may be restricted.

If neither Motorsport Australia accreditation or complete employers insurance coverage is held by the applicant, it should be anticipated that the application will be declined.

Media accreditation applications must be submitted at least two (2) weeks prior to the commencement of the applicable SCCSA event.

Images must also be submitted to the Sporting Car Club of South Australia within two weeks after the event has taken place. The SCCSA reserves the right to use images and video for promotional purposes.
